## 1: HART Carpool Referral Program

HART's Carpool Referral Program provides existing registered carpools with an incentive to promote NJDOT's "**Carpooling Makes Sense**" Program to co-workers, friends, family\*.

### Program Guidelines

- A \$100 pre-paid gas card to be paid to an existing registered carpool that refers a new carpool to HART.
- The newly registered carpool must complete the requirements of participation in NJDOT's "**Carpooling Makes Sense**" Program (24 days in 60 consecutive days) for the referring carpool to receive a gas card.
- \*Referred carpool must travel to a Hunterdon County worksite as its final destination.
- Referring carpool must be registered with HART, but does not have to be a current or past participant in the "**Carpooling Makes Sense**" Program.
- Limit 2 referrals per carpool per program year.

## 2: HART Carpool Rider Bonus Program

Provides commuters with an added incentive to form a carpool with 3 or more people from the start, or add riders to an existing carpool.



### Program Guidelines

#### New Carpools

- \$50 prepaid gas card offered to the carpool for each carpool participant beyond the first 2 people, up to a maximum of 2 additional participants at the time of registration. (maximum \$100 gas card per 4 person carpool. All participants must carpool at the same time).
- Carpool must be newly registered with HART in the NJDOT "Carpooling Makes Sense" Program.
- Carpool must complete the requirements of the "Carpooling Makes Sense" Program in order to receive gas card.

#### Existing Carpools

- \$50 prepaid gas card offered to existing registered carpools for each rider added to the carpool beyond the first two people. (Carpool participants must all be participating at the same time)
- Added rider(s) must participate in the carpool at least 3 days per week during a consecutive two month period in order for the carpool to receive the gas card.
